Our Education Enrichment Program reaches a wider range of children across the counties. As a member of Charleston's Promise, our agency has pledged service to children by involving caring adults in the lives of the children in Charleston, Berkeley, and Dorchester Counties.

All programs and services are free of charge to those meeting the eligibility requirements.

South Carolina Youth Leadership

The mission of SCYL is to systematically facilitate a statewide Youth Leadership Program that encourages and enhances character building, educational achievement, civic responsibility, and career exploration for the purpose of developing life and leadership skills in eligible youths. The program is funded by the SC Governor's Office of Economic Opportunity and is open to students in k-12th grade, attending SC schools.



Seasonal Programs

School Uniforms

Our agency provides seasonal school uniforms for income eligible children and those living in shelters, group homes, and transitional housing. Summer Youth Works!

Young adults who are high school juniors or seniors or who are current college students can participate in the *Summer Youth Works!* seasonal employment program. Participants gain job experience and compensation while building their resume.

Youth Leadership Summer Camp

Each year the agency sponsors a free four-week Youth Leadership summer camp for students from ages 5-12. Campers receive daily instruction from certified teachers in Math and Language Arts. Camp activities also include: arts, crafts, character education, financial literacy, etiquette, energy conservation, educational trips, career planning, speakers from various careers, physical education, health/nutritional classes, and community service performed by children. Parenting classes are also offered.
